



Statement from Independent Chair of the Safeguarding Adults Board for Cornwall and The Isles of Scilly – Fiona Field

15 October 2025

This Safeguarding Adults Review (SAR) has reviewed the circumstances of a man with autism and complex health needs who experienced problems getting the support he needed.

I am aware that services are continuing to offer support services to the individual and his family. We are not publishing the full report to protect their privacy.

We commissioned the SAR to learn from the problems experienced by the family and by service providers.

The Learning Briefing summarises the recommendations from the SAR. These recommendations have been agreed by the partners on the Safeguarding Adults Board (SAB) in full.

Actions will be identified and taken forward by the SAB so that learning is shared and importantly, services can improve for local people.
